

“Kahoot your country!”

Projektā “Kahoot your country!” piedalījās skolēni no 24 Eiropas valstīm, lai interaktīvā un aizraujošā veidā iepazīstinātu citus ar savu valsti. Katras valsts skolēni sagatavoja jautājumus par nozīmīgām tēmām – ģeogrāfiju, vēsturi, kultūru, tradīcijām, ēdieniem, dabas objektiem un ikdienas dzīvi. No šiem jautājumiem tika izveidotas viktorīnas Kahoot! platformā, ko spēlēja projekta dalībnieki no visas Eiropas.

Latviju šajā projektā pārstāvēja Liepājas Centra sākumskolas 6. klašu skolēni. Viņi izstrādāja jautājumus par Latvijas kultūru, simboliem, vēstures faktiem un īpašām vietām, tādējādi veicinot gan savu interesi par dzimteni, gan lepnumu par piederību tai.

Projekts veicināja:

- digitālo prasmju attīstību, izmantojot Kahoot! platformu;
- sadarbību starptautiskā mērogā;
- komunikācijas prasmes angļu valodā;
- izpratni par Eiropas valstu daudzveidību un kultūru bagātību.

Skolēniem šī bija aizraujoša iespēja vienlaikus mācīties un mācīt citus – ar spēles elementiem padarot mācību procesu radošu un motivējošu. Projekts sekmēja arī savstarpēju draudzību un Eiropas identitātes stiprināšanu.
